



To start the process, you need to submit a short-term

disability claim form before your delivery. To submit a claim, please see your employer for instructions.

Will I receive short-term disability bene ts if I stop working before my due date?

We acknowledge disability up to one week prior to your expected or actual date of delivery. If you have medical complications that prevent you from doing your job, your doctor should submit the appropriate medical records, and we may provide bene ts prior to that date.

What happens if I live in a state with Statutory Disability or Pto open a claim or follow the directions on the claim bene ts? forms. Make sure all forms are completed and signed ort-term disability bene ts typically end six weeks by the appropriate individuals, as missing information fler your delivery date. or signatures can delay your claim.

Bene t payments may extend beyond six weeks if there are medical complications. Your doctor must provide certi cation that the covered disability will last more than the initial six weeks. This certi cation would include a note from your doctor explaining the extension of your leave as well as copies of your medical records. We will then review your medical records against the physical requirements of your job and determine if we will extend your bene ts.

For a C-section, we may extend disability bene ts up to an additional two weeks, for a total of up to eight weeks beyond your delivery date. Please note that the Elimination Period will still apply.

What if I am able to return to work before six weeks?

Simply call Sun Life and tell us you are returning to work earlier than expected.

When do my bene ts begin?

Typically, your covered disability begins on the day you deliver. However, you may have to wait for a short period of time (called an Elimination Period) before you begin receiving your short-term disability bene t checks. Ask your employer or refer to your short-term disability booklet to determine the length of your Elimination Period.

Will I receive disability bene ts for each week of my maternity leave? I was told I was eligible for six weeks of disability bene ts, but why did I receive only ve checks?

The payments you receive may vary. The number of weeks for which you receive disability bene t payments is based on the approved weeks of disability minus the Elimination Period. For example, if you deliver on January 15 and have a seven-day Elimination Period (the period of time between your disability start date and your rst bene t payment date), your bene t payments would begin on January 22 and would end six weeks after the date you delivered, on February 25. In this scenario, you would receive ve weeks of disability bene ts due to the seven-day Elimination Period.

Isn't everyone eligible for 12 weeks of leave? Employees eligible under the federal Family and Medical Leave Act (FMLA) can take up to twelve +7 day
