Many federal agencies will accept the Just-Time Institutional Review Board (IRB) Review. The sponsor's instructions should stipulate IRB approval or pending approval is required at the time of proposal submission or the sponsor acknowledges acceptance of Just-Time IRB Review.

NOTE: By signing this statement the investigator acknowledges that all IRB requirements will be secured before initiation of the proposed project, recruitment of subjects and any data collection. All investigators utilizing this type of review process are required to submit this signed statement with the university transmittal sheet indicating applied, you may submit a new project application to the IRB Office prior to the notice of funding in order to avoid delays in the start date. There will be no exceptions to the regular scheduled IRB deadlines because funding is pending for a proposal, and is not possible to guarantee IRB approval in advance of the review process.

Investigators who learn that their proposal may be funded should submit a new project application to the IRB Office for review. No portion of the proposed research can be conducted until the proposal has been reviewed.

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
